The preferred candidate will leverage education, training, and experience equivalent to a Masters degree in a health research, healthcare or clinical research discipline or equivalent experience with a minimum of five (5) years' of practical quality, project coordination or research work experience. An equivalent combination of education, training and experience may be considered.
