The Director will lead a team and collaborate closely with other departments to align resources with the organization's strategic goals.

This is an exciting opportunity for a passionate finance professional who is passionate about inclusive, community centred programs and services. The ideal candidate will have a bachelor's degree and CPA or CGA designation with a minimum of ten years of progressive experience in accounting and finance. Experience working in the not-for-profit sector and/or social enterprise is preferred. The preferred candidate will have demonstrated leadership experience and sensitivity to working in a culturally diverse environment with the ability to communicate effectively with a range of people including Deaf, DeafBlind and Hard of Hearing individuals. Wavefront is a bilingual environment (ASL/English), fluency in American Sign Language (ASL) is an asset for this position.

Annual salary range of approximately \$102,102 to \$138,138 supplemented by a competitive total compensation package. Actual salary will be determined based on the candidate's experience, expertise, and Wavefront Centre's internal equity guidelines.
